A closed group course specially designed to provide a business English curriculum with professional development and 2 outside visits. All course materials, **Business Examination** and End of Course Certificate included. Minimum English level B1.

Accommodation: *Student Residence in Galway (only available **June, July, August**):

Your group will be placed in a Student Residence building located in the city. Twin shared standard room residential accommodation. Self-catering only i.e. no meals are included. In certain cases, accommodation may be shared with other GBS students depending on the group size. 17-year-olds are possible if they are accompanied by a teacher who must also stay in the student accommodation. En-suite rooms (additional €50/week). The complex consists of 112 apartments, comprising a mix of two- and three-bedroom units, each accommodating between three and five people. Bedrooms vary in type: some are twin occupancy, some are single occupancy, and some are doubles, furnished with a double bed but allocated for single occupancy only. Apart from differences in size and bed type, all bedrooms are equipped with the same facilities, including a built-in wardrobe, a built-in study desk, and a bedside locker with study lamp.

Course Planning:

- Prior to arrival, the trainee will take an online test (written test) to define their level of language.
- A needs analysis questionnaire will be completed by each trainee to define more precisely and validate the content of the course.
- An orientation session will be provided on the first day of the programme to introduce the staff and the training programme.
- Students would need to bring an electronic device on which they can do their assignment (laptop/tablet)

Course Specific Objectives:

- Allow the trainee to improve his/her overall English language level and become more confident speaking English.
- Focus on business English language skills for use in the trainee's professional development.
- Improve intercultural competences, better understand the history & culture of Ireland and its economic system.
- Improve presentation skills, be able to make a presentation effectively and confidently.
- Improve business communication skills, be able to write business letters, reports with proposals, memos, and emails.
- Improve personal and social competences, allow the trainee to understand his personal strengths and weaknesses in English.

Project Work Module:

- All trainees will work on a presentation during the programme.
- Each candidate will prepare and deliver a 15-minute group presentation in the final week.

Assessment Procedure:

- The course is assessed by both formative and summative means i.e. assessments are completed both during and at the end of the course.
- There is an assessed individual written assignment (250 words) submitted in the second week. A clear grading rubric is provided.
- There is an assessed 15-minute group presentation in the final week (each person graded individually). A clear grading rubric is provided.
- There is a formal written examination on Friday morning of the final week.
- Course participation is assessed throughout the three weeks including independent course work on the learning platform, Moodle and in-class participation

Assessment Breakdown

- Course participation
 - 10% Online Components (E-lessons on Moodle)
 - 10% Forum Contributions (Forum on Moodle)
 - 10% In-Class Participation
- Summative Assessment
 - 25% Group Presentation (10-15 minutes oral group presentation, Week 3)
 - 25% Written Assignment
 - 20% End of Course Test
