Your group will be placed with carefully selected host families, single occupancy room, full board, with packed lunch and lift to and from the Business English Language School daily.

Student Residence in Thomastown / Kilkenny: (Additional charge/ fee)

LXI do not provide alternative student residence. However, we will issue a local list of B&B, Hostel and Hotel accommodation for students who wish to live independently.

Included Outside Visits: Two outside Company Visits in Dublin and Waterford city via train, included.

Airport Transfers: Airport Meeting & greet for all Flight arrivals on Sunday between 9am to 2pm. Airport transfer included to Thomastown.

Not included:

- Dietary requirements including gluten free, dairy free, vegetarian, halal – your students purchase their own food of choice and bring it to their Host Family – at their own discretion. This is not part of our offering.
- Weekend travel and activities are managed by the students themselves. This is not part of our offering. Friday afternoon train / bus travel allows for access to Dublin, Belfast, Galway, Cork etc at the student's own expense. Or they can remain at the HF and enjoy the local attractions of the south-east of Ireland – a popular tourism destination for millions, annually.
- Late flight arrivals, after 2pm on a Sunday, can avail of limited bus transfers to Kilkenny city on Sunday evenings – to be collected by their HF. Tickets range from € 25-30pp. This individual late bus transfer is not part of the LXI offering. Please keep this in mind when booking flights – try to book arrival before 2pm, on the Sunday.

Course Planning:

- Registration on-line via our CRM. Optional e-learning LXI 'Preparation for employment' modules made available.
- FAQ's and CRM Help Desk available 24/7 as a student resource.
- Student profile preparation – to be evaluated in the course around personal marketing & job interviews.
- Placement test online and pre arrival login to AI software. Digital diary of events issues 8-10 days in advance of arrival.
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- Tailored Business English programme to meet the specific needs of each group in preparation for the Kaufmann International Certificate. The class timetable is delivered both morning and afternoon. Morning classes will focus on specific language development while the afternoon programme is a mix of Company visits, self-study and teacher led preparation for the end of course presentation. In total the programme duration is 33 hours per week.
- Project work – business case study around the River Nore passing through Kilkenny & Thomastown - its contribution to business, sustainability, river economics, flood damage, costs, climate action, prevention, invasive species, riverbank development projects, municipal tendering, contracts, project works, cost overruns, economic benefit to Thomastown - with final presentation and daily diaries. This will broaden student vocabulary around National Government & Local Authority run project(s).
- Students would need to bring an electronic device on which they can do their assignment (laptop/tablet).
- One evening social programme and two afternoon cultural trips, included.
- Ongoing assistance during their stay.
- Emergency number 24/7

Course Specific Objectives:

- Allow the trainee to improve his/her overall English language level and become more confident speaking English.
- Focus on business English language skills for use in the trainee's professional development
- Better understand the history & culture of Ireland and its economic system.
- The economics of sustainability and climate action.
- Be able to make a presentation effectively and confidently.
- Be able to write business letters, reports with proposals, memos, emails and market oneself at interviews.
- Allow the trainee to understand their personal strengths and weaknesses in English.
- AI software allows 24/7 access to further lessons over 3 months of access. Allowing further student initiative.
- Better understanding of our natural resources, our interaction with them, sustainability & climate action measures required.

Project Work Module:

- All trainees will work on a presentation during the course. A class will be split in groups of 2 or 3; to research a specific topic related to one group presentation, at the end.
- Each candidate will make a prepared 15-minute presentation in the final week. Collective presentation on a local Irish topic.

Assessment Procedure:

Formal examination on the Thursday morning of the final week. Participants will complete a written and oral exam including presentation of a completed project.

A Sustainable Language School:

Before arrival – we encourage all our participants to consider the Carbon Offset opportunity that comes with the purchase of flight tickets. At the point of final invoice payment, LXI will refund students their carbon offset cost on all Aer Lingus, Ryanair and Lufthansa flights. Making your travel to Ireland carbon neutral.

While here in Ireland participants will experience our coach transfers pooling, public transport, host family car-pooling, household energy pooling and our energy which is currently 38% Irish renewable energy. Our school premises works off solar and renewable energy sources, and our Thomastown community have commenced an 11x acre Island rewilding project, on the banks of the river Nore in which students will get to visit, understand and experience biodiversity first-hand.
